1. About the Academy

Central Academy for State Forest Service, Coimbatore

1.1 Brief Introduction



The Central Academy for State Forest Service, Coimbatore is one of the premier institutions under the aegis of Directorate of Forest Education, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, which imparts professional Induction training to newly

recruited State Forest Officers (ACF) and Forest Range Officers (FRO) from various states and offers in-service training to the State Forest Service Officers of DCF, ACF, FRO and Deputy FRO ranks.

With the advent of various developmental schemes in the Forestry sector during the IV and V Five year plans, and launching of the Social Forestry Projects in many States, the Government of India felt the urgency of starting two more institutions to train the increasing number of officers specially from the State Services, and as a sequel to this the State Forest Service College, Coimbatore was established on 25th January, 1980. Later it was rechristened as Central Academy for State Forest Service (CASFOS).

1.2 Mission & objective

- To bring out Forestry Professionals capable of meeting future challenges in the sphere of Forests, Wildlife & Environment through capacity building & knowledge sharing.
- Strengthening existing management process and disseminating new concepts through continued education, in the shape of in-service courses to augment his/her managerial skills with administrative & technical acumen.
- Conducting special and refresher courses covering emerging issues in forestry research and technology.
- Re-orienting basis of forest education in tune with requisite parameters of ecology and environment.

1.3 Location:

Setup in the picturesque Forest Campus, R.S. Puram, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu, the Central Academy for State Forest Service is situated at a distance of 5 km from the Coimbatore Railway Station and 22 Km. from Coimbatore International Airport. The Academy shares the space of the exquisite Forest Campus along with 2 more premier forestry institutions viz., Tamil Nadu Forest Academy -TNFA (erstwhile Madras Forest College & SFRC), and Institute of Forest Genetics & Tree breeding - IFG & TB, one of the leading research institutes under Indian Council Forest Research and Education. This campus also houses the famous 'GASS MUSEUM'.

1.4 Genesis:

With the advent of various developmental schemes in the Forestry sector during the IV and V Five year plans, and launching of the Social Forestry Projects in many States, the Government of India felt the urgency of starting two more institutions to train the increasing number of officers specially from the State Services, and as a sequel to this the State Forest Service College, Coimbatore was established on 25th January, 1980. Earlier to this, the State Forest Service Officers had been were trained at the erstwhile Indian Forest College, Dehra Dun and State Forest Service College, Burnihat. Later SFS College Coimbatore was elevated as an Academy in the year 2009 and was rechristened as the Central Academy for State Forest Service (CASFOS), Coimbatore.

1.5 Facilities & Infrastructure

Central Academy for State Forest Service, Coimbatore is an ideal setting for the pursuit of forestry training. It is housed in a beautiful building with well-furnished Classrooms, a Library, Laboratories, Computer labs, Lecture halls and a Conference hall. Hostel facilities are ensured at the "Chandan Hostel" and Executive Hostel.

1.5.1 Library & Knowledge Centre: The CASFOS Coimbatore Library is fully Air-Conditioned and has more than 11000 documents in the form of Books, Lecture notes and Back volumes on subjects like Forestry, Environment, Wildlife, Ecology and subscribes 20 nos. of current periodicals, journals, newsletters and dailies. Auto Lib software is used to manage library database and circulation activities. Photocopying facility is available to provide Reprographic Service. The library Knowledge Center consists of mini Computer Lab with Wi-Fi Internet connectivity to facilitate Digital Library activities for online reference.

1.5.2 Computer facilities: GIS Computer lab is equipped with 41nos. of latest models of new Desktop Computers installed with Imagine ArcGIS & ERDAS software procured under JICA Project. The lab has LCD Projector, Laser Printers, Scanner and FTTH internet connectivity to impart training programs on Application of Modern Tools and Techniques in Forestry. Similarly, a mini Computer lab facility is available at “Chandan Hostel” premises with FTTH Internet connectivity to facilitate the Officer Trainees to work at hostel after class room hours.

1.5.3 Lecture Halls & Laboratory: There are two fully Air-conditioned Lecture halls equipped with smart class room facilities for conducting class room lectures.

1.5.4 Conference Halls: There are two Air-conditioned Conference Halls namely “Jim Corbett Hall” and “Champion Hall” fully furnished and equipped with LCD Projectors, conferencing system and Computers for conducting workshops, conferences, convocation and other functions.

1.5.5 Chandan Hostel: The training is fully residential. Residential accommodation on single occupancy basis is available to all the trainees in the 'CHANDAN' hostel of the college. The hostel has a capacity of 104 single rooms & 15 single suites and 5 double suites. The hostel has common room facilities with TV, newspapers & telephone connection. There is a small lounge hall for recreation purposes

1.5.6 Vanvatika –Lounge Hall the Lounge Hall is spacious for conducting cultural programs and photographic exhibitions as part of the training activities. It consists of two Air conditioned suits for accommodating guests.

1.5.7 Executive Hostel: A new Executive Hostel was constructed with the sanctioned amount of .4.37 Cr. under the JICA Funded project to accommodate in-service SFS officers during the Refresher courses and Theme based workshops. The Executive Hostel consists of 8 (eight) Double Rooms, 2 (two) VIP Suites in the Ground Floor and 16 (sixteen) Double Rooms in the First Floor.

1.5.8 Sports: The objective of the Induction Training is overall personality development, with emphasis on field training in addition to the theoretical aspects. Physical training and Sports constitute an important part of the curriculum and are compulsory. The Academy has sprawling grounds for outdoor sports & games, with facilities for Tennis, Basketball, Volleyball, Cricket, Football, and Hockey & Athletics. Indoor facilities include a modern Gymnasium, Table tennis, Badminton & Board games.

1.6 Human resources at CASFOS Coimbatore:

The Academy has experienced and qualified pool of officers belonging to the elite Indian Forest Service deputed as faculties to impart training at CASFOS, Coimbatore. The Posts of Principal and the Lecturers are filled up through deputation of willing and eligible officers from various states of India.

In addition, the training curriculum is efficiently implemented through a permanent faculty for Engineering & Surveying, Sports Officer and a PT & Games Instructor.

The Academy also ropes in eminent forest Officers serving as well as retired, and resource persons from other reputed forestry institutions, specialists and professionals as Guest Faculty from time to time, to give quality inputs on all aspects of forestry.



1.7 Status of Training activities conducted at CASFOS Coimbatore

The induction training conducted for SFS recruits (ACF) is of two years duration, and its 18 months for FROs. After successful completion of the training the officers are awarded Diploma/Certificate in Forestry. This academy has the capacity to conduct Induction Training to 80 Officers at a time in two Batches of 40 each.

- Since 1980, this Academy has conducted 26 Induction Courses to SFS Officers and a total of 875 ACFs have been passed out from this Academy.
- Similarly since 2000, a total of 369 FROs have completed Induction Training of 18 months duration in 13 Batches.
- At present two courses of Induction training are being conducted. The 2020-22 SFS course consists of 45 Officer Trainees and the 2021-22 FRO course consists of 37 Officer Trainees.
- The Academy also conducts in-service training courses for State Forest Service Officers in the ranks of DCF, ACF, FRO, Deputy FRO and Foresters. So far, 228 training courses have been conducted in the form of General Refresher Courses, TOT, Workshops on Theme based & Contemporary Forest Management, Computer Applications and MTT. A total of 2783 in-service officers have participated in those courses.
- Apart from this the Academy has conducted 4 training programs for other stakeholders and 2 Seminars/Symposiums for forest officers. A total of 242 participants have been benefited.







Image of Interactive session with participant officer during the online – Theme based workshop on Human Resource Management

Image of Online session of General Refresher Course conducted at CASFOS Coimbatore





Image of Online session of General awareness Course on Conservation of Forests, Wildlife and Environment: "Know your Forests" conducted at CASFOS Coimbatore



6. Write up of “Swachhta Abhiyan” conducted during 2019-2020



Swachh Bharat Abhiyan was observed on 2nd October, 2020 and the Office premises, hostel premises and the campus have been cleaned voluntarily by the Trainees, Officers and Staff. The Academy has followed the guidelines of Government with respect to Cleanliness Drive. Apart from regular training activities all the officer trainees are encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities.




